Heritage of Faith
2 Timothy 1

Paul is near the end of his life—**2 Timothy 4:6-8**. He is alone because all have turned away from him because of His chains—except one (**Verses 15-17**).

He writes to encourage his spiritual son, Timothy. He is concerned about the future of the church and the message of the Gospel.

He knows Timothy will encounter trials and trouble and will have to suffer—**Verse 4:3-5**. He encourages Timothy to:

1. Live out your faith—**Verse 1:4-6**.
2. Your faith conquers fear—**Verse 7**
3. Don't be ashamed of the Gospel or your mentor—**Verse 8a**
4. Don't be afraid to suffer because of your faith.
5. You exist to execute God's plan.
6. God's plan is made plain through Jesus.
