Luke 6:4-46 NLT, NKJV

- To have faith means that I trust God – **Hebrews 11:6**
- To trust God means that I do what He says – **Luke 6:46**
- There should never be a time when the believer who obeys the Lord, does not trust the Lord – **Proverbs 3:5-6, Job 13:15**
- Trouble is an opportunity for the believer to demonstrate their trust in the Lord, not to develop it. Trust is developed through obeying the Lord before the trouble comes. **Luke 6:47**
- Trouble is certain to come into each of our lives, it's only a matter of time. The believer who trust the Lord will always be ready whenever the trouble shows up – **Luke 6:48**
- Trust guarantees that the believer will be able to withstand any trouble that comes. Luke 6:48b.
- Disobedience demonstrates a lack of trust in the Lord – **Luke 6:49**
- Disobedience assures that the person will not be ready for trouble and will crumble because of the trouble - **Luke 6:49**
